All students are being educated about the Beagle Bay community and they are also being taught about the value of literacy and education as a means of eradicating poverty.



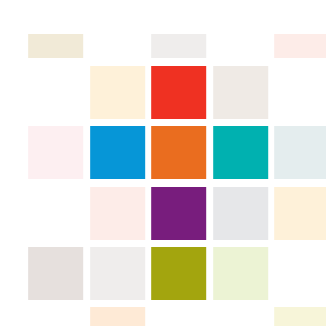
