Good Shepherd Catholic School has always endeavoured to provide support for students with disability however, it was apparent to staff that many students with disability identified as having physical, attention, social, emotional and behavioural sensory needs that were not being met.

In response, the school introduced the Sensory Motor Program in February 2018 which involves students participating in physical activities that focus on developing vestibular, proprioceptive, and tactile sensations.

With a team of staff, students work in pairs and rotate through activities in 30 minute sessions four times a week. The program also includes Tae Kwon Do and gardening sessions, plus cooking and Lego clubs.
